

Falmouth Classics

Information for vessels with pre-booked alongside berths, moorings or anchorage

Unless otherwise informed, alongside berths, mooring and anchorage preferences will have been reserved on receiving your entry form. Once the mooring and alongside berths and moorings are full this will appear on the entry form when only free anchorage will remain.

Vessels are advised to arrive on Thursday 16th June from 11.00 onwards.

On approaching Black Rock, call "Falmouth Haven" on VHF Channel 12. Intimate that you are arriving for "Falmouth Classics" and have booked a berth, mooring or anchorage. You will then be directed to your allocated area.

On passing the Docks, you may or may not be met by a rib or launch which will welcome you. If not, the Classic's berthing masters and their team will be on the pontoons to direct you to your berth, mooring or anchorage and will provide you with any help you might require.

On arrival, the berthing team will be pleased to give you any information that you require. The mobile number will be 07555 565783 **but they will also be able to communicate on VHF CH 12.**

Registration takes place at the Regatta Office located in the Windjammer (aka Falmouth Watersports Centre) at the following times:

Tuesday 14th and Wednesday 15th 12.30 – 16.30

Thursday 16th - from 1200 to 16.30

Friday 17th - from 09.00 to 1200.

Saturday 18th - from 09.00 – 10.00

At registration you will be able to pick up your Welcome Packs, book for the barbecue (if you haven't already done so until 12.00 noon on Friday 17th) and collect merchandise which has been pre ordered.
